Characterized by hot summer days with huge diurnal swings into lower temperatures at night, Happy Canyon AVA is the premiere region for ripening Bordeaux varietals in Santa Barbara County. Large cobbles of serpentine stone force grapevines to dig deep and struggle for sufficient nutrients and water, which produces low-yields and high-quality fruit. This label refresh for our classic Black Label Siempre Malbec features our landmark adobe, situating it as the signature wine of the Adobe Series labels, all of which feature notable figures in the long and rich history of our property.
