Peake Ranch lies on the eastern side of the Sta. Rita Hills off of the iconic Santa Rosa Road. Planted on extremely steep rolling hillsides with exposure to the cool air that rolls in off of the Pacific Ocean, the vines produce age-worthy and structured fruit.

The Swan clone, known for its small, intensely flavored berries and lifted aromatics, brings depth and elegance to this vintage from Peake Ranch. Grown in the cool marine-influenced hills of Santa Rita, it yields a Pinot Noir layered with raspberry, red plum, rose petal, and baking spice. Silky tannins and vibrant acidity frame the wine, offering both immediacy and aging potential.
