Garey Vineyard is located in the heart of the Santa Maria Valley AVA, the third oldest AVA in the United States. With a cool Mediterranean climate well-suited for Pinot Noir, fruit from this region is known for its brightness and levity of character, tempered by a distinctive underlying soil element that we cherish. We foster those desirable site elements through native yeast fermentation, whole cluster inclusion, and unfiltered bottling.

Aromas of wild strawberry, dried herbs, and white pepper lead into a silky, savory palate layered with red cherry, forest floor, and baking spice. A beautiful match for grilled salmon, roast duck, or mushroom risotto.
