Typically used for blending in the Rhône Valley, we highlight our 1.25-acre parcel of Tablas clone Mourvèdre in an annual varietal bottling that showcases the unique qualities of this grape. We love the depth of fruit and elegant structural strength, buoyed by silky smooth tannins on the finish.

This vintage of our Estate Mourvèdre opens with inviting aromas of black cherry and boysenberry, accented by hints of violet, sandalwood, and dried sage. On the palate, it's generous and supple, with layers of dark fruit and a firm yet refined tannic frame. The finish is expansive, carrying notes of clove, smoked meat, and cocoa powder for a savory, lingering impression.
