Our new vintage of this clone 877 Syrah is intensely expressive, offering layers of black raspberry and blueberry compote framed by robust tannins. Hints of cracked pepper, cured olive, and roasted espresso deepen the profile, making it an ideal companion for charred meats, wild game, or a wedge of aged Manchego.
