2024 BRASSMAN WHITE

A bright, expressive Rhône-white blend. Fermented in stainless steel, it opens with fresh aromas of white peach and lime zest. Clean and vibrant on the palate, with hints of green apple and citrus blossom. Perfect alongside grilled shrimp, soft cheeses, or spring vegetables.

2024 VINTAGE NOTES

The 2024 growing season across Santa Barbara County began with a mild winter and steady spring that encouraged even development. Moderate summer temperatures and coastal winds supported balanced ripening with minimal heat. Slightly lighter yields enhanced concentration while preserving acidity. The wines show vibrant fruit and fresh structure shaped by maritime influence.

VINEYARD SOURCE NOTES

Nolan Ranch in the Alisos Canyon AVA and Camp 4 Vineyard in the Santa Ynez Valley offer distinct expressions of Santa Barbara terroir. Warm days, cool evenings, and coastal winds encourage even ripening. Sandy, well-draining soils provide structure, while sustainable farming preserves balance and site expression.
