2022 CHATEAU DUPLANTIER

This refreshing blend of 42% Syrah, 21% Petite Sirah, 21% Mourvèdre, and 16% Grenache manages to be both invigorating and rich. Aromas of pomegranate, raspberry and wild thyme lead into a palate of berry, cranberry and toasted herb. It's complex yet quaffable.

2022 RESERVE SYRAH

The use of oak brings out some of the more interesting cool-climate components of this Syrah. Vivid aromas of raspberry, lavender, thyme, and pepper dust verge toward raw meat on the nose. The palate's lavender and peppercorn core decorates the fringes of savory herb and snappy raspberry-cherry fruits. The finish is toasty.



2024 ESTATE VIOGNIER

This expertly crafted Viognier by the estate's longtime winemaker Adrienne Rule, starts with clean aromas of melon, stone fruit, and white flowers on the nose. The palate is wrapped in a tight texture and awash in persistent acidity that flows through the apple, ripe melon, and citrus flavors.



2024 ESTATE ROUSSANNE

This is a tightly wound version of Roussanne, starting with aromas of lime granita and wet stone on the nose. The palate carries some of that earthy minerality into flavors of honeydew and lime peel.



2022 ESTATE SYRAH

This is a joyous, easy drinking style of Syrah, beginning with aromas of roasted red berry, brisk plum, thyme and a hint of fennel pollen on the nose. The palate is playful and refreshing, as red fruit and white pepper spice work in harmony.
