

RIDEAU VINEYARD

2022 ENCHEVÊTRÉ ROUGE

This Rhône-style blend of 37% Mourvèdre, 34% Syrah, and 29% Grenache leads with inviting aromas of dark berry compote, lavender, and wild herbs. On the palate, Syrah brings plush plum and cracked pepper, while Mourvèdre and Grenache add layers of cherry skin, cocoa dust, and a savory edge of dried thyme. The structure is firm yet elegant, with a long, spice-laced finish.

2022 VINTAGE NOTES

Warm, sunny conditions and below-average rainfall shaped the 2022 season in the Los Olivos District, driving steady ripening. A Labor Day heat spike and light harvest rains required careful timing, preserving balance and freshness. The wines show concentrated fruit, vibrant acidity, and layered spice, with depth and structure reflective of the district's warm days and cool nights.

VINEYARD SOURCE NOTES

Camp 4 Vineyard sits on the eastern edge of the Santa Ynez Valley, where warm days, cool maritime evenings, and sandy loam and clay soils create ideal conditions for Rhône varieties. Sustainable farming preserves the purity and character that make Camp 4 one of the region's most respected sources for Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre.
